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Get your fixed teeth IN 72 Hours.... Yes Its Possible

Taking care of our health starts with our teeth, if our teeth are healthy, strong, we can eat any food, but many patients have the problem of missing teeth or premature tooth loss or there are many patients who lose their teeth in an accident.

There are so many options to replace the teeth like Removable Dentures, Crown and Bridges, Patient specific implants, zygomas and Dental Implants (Either Conventional implants or Basal Implants). All these methods have their advantages and disadvantages, so before taking treatment everyone atleast enquire about it.

The best option to get fixed teeth in three days is Corticobasal Implants.

Question 1 - What is an implant and what are its types?

An implant is made of titanium metal and acts as an artificial root for your tooth, it is transplanted into the bone and then the tooth is placed.

There are two types of implants.

1) Corticobasal implant can be done non-invasively and non-surgically. And beauty of this implantology is patient will get Fixed teeth installation in 3 days,

2) Conventional implants- These are transplanted into the bone surgically first. In this procedure, patients get stitches and the process of implanting the teeth takes 3 to 4 months. This procedure is a bit painful and it requires adequate bone height.

Question 2- Doctor, I want to fix my teeth quickly, also I am afraid of surgery and stitches, so can I do implants or not?

Answer- Easily possible through this Corticobasal implantology, these implants are implanted on your gums without any surgery or stitches. These implants are fixed to the strongest part of your bone, i. e. Cortical Bone, and you can easily get your teeth installed in 3 days without swelling or stitches. This procedure involves eating soft foods for the first two months and then any all solid foods.

Question 3- Doctor, my grandmother is 90 years old and has diabetes and heart disease, so can fixed teeth be installed in such patients?

These implants are a boon to the patient with diabetic, Heart diseases, Periodontal diseases and also in smokers, as these smooth polished implants do not get any bacterial attack, hence the patients do not get any infection.

Diabetic patients need to control sugar during the procedure. Even elderly patients can get their fixed teeth fitted with implants

Question 4- Doctor, in my father's upper jaw the teeth have been removed due to Mucormycosis (Black fungus) during Corona, can we also get fixed teeth?

Answer- Sure... Basal implants can be fixed in one part of upper and lower jaw i.e. not only fixed in cortical bone but also in zygoma and glabella. This procedure can be done without any hospitalisation. Therefore, in cancer patients or in patients with muco-mycosis who have undergone surgical loss of the upper jaw. Those patients can also get fixed teeth through cortico-basal



implants and thus can change their lifestyle.

Question 5 - Doctor, I am 25 years old and I also want fixed teeth through implants. Can it be?

Answer- Yes of-course. After maturity that is possible. Average maturity age in Indian population is 18-21 year.

Question 6- Doctor can you elaborate the procedure in short ?

This is how the surgery done.

First day

On the first day, the teeth or jaw are anesthetized. The anesthesia is limited to the area where we want to place the implants. Complete unconsciousness (Hospitalization) is not required. The upper and lower jaw implants are seated and completed in a two to three hour procedure. After that it is necessary to follow the given medicines and regimen.

Second day

On the next day, without any surgery, the measurements are taken in just 30 to 40 minutes and the resulting metal try-in and measurements are observed

Third day

There is no need for anesthesia on the second and third day. Even on the third day, fixed teeth are installed in just 30 to 40 minutes. After that, one has to come for re-examination in a period of one month, three months, six months and one year. And on the same time patient can chew the food.

Having fixed teeth within 72 hours can drastically improve quality of life by restoring functionality, confidence, and overall oral health in a timely manner, ensuring minimal disruption to daily activities and promoting a swift recovery.
